Program Timeline:

Phase 1: Mentor Enrolment

Opens: 18th April 2026

Closes: 28th April 2026

Purpose:

To create a high-quality mentor pool before mentee applications begin.

Phase 2: Mentee Enrolment

Opens: 1st May 2026

Closes: 20th May 2026

Purpose:

To allow mentees to clearly define their learning goals based on the available mentor expertise.

Phase 3: Matching & Program Start

Matching Period: 21st May 2026 – 30th May 2026

Mentorship Duration: 1st June – 31st December (6 months)

- **Demonstrated academic, clinical, or leadership contributions**
- **Willingness to mentor 1–2 mentees only**

Applicants must provide:

- ISOT Membership Number
- Career stage
- **Top 3 learning objectives**
- Expected outcomes (**At 6 months**)
- Upload **CV (PDF)**

Matching Process

Matching will be based on:

- Mentee's selected goals
- Mentor's declared expertise

- Alignment of expectations
- Language and regional comfort (when possible)

Mentors will **approve mentee allocation before final confirmation.**

Mentorship Structure

- Mode: **Zoom / WhatsApp / Email**
- **First meeting:** Goal setting and roadmap
- Duration: **6 months**
